Whether you're looking to upgrade an Android device forsaken by its manufacturer or you just want more control over the phone or tablet you own, you've probably gone looking for a new ROM. Rooting your phone is the first step, but a new ROM will give you a completely new mobile OS, and this week we're going to look at five of the best Android ROMs, based on your nominations. Earlier in the week, we asked you which Android ROMs you thought were the best. We took your nominations, tallied them up, and now we're back to highlight the top five. It's important to note that not every ROM is available for every device, and different ROMs are aimed at different audiences—some of them are designed to upgrade the OS and others are lean and mean installs to speed up your phone. Whichever you choose, you'll have to make sure your device is supported by the developers behind the ROM before installing. If your Android device is feeling a little stale, or maybe the manufacturer has abandoned it and...Read moreCyanogenModCyanogenMod is arguably one of the (if not the) most installed Android ROM in the world, and for good reason. It offers a ton of great features, is available for more devices than most other ROMs of its type, and has the type of polish and support that makes it easy to fall in love with. There are builds of CyanogenMod for Android phones and tablets, and slowly but surely the developers behind CyanogenMod are rolling out Ice Cream Sandwich versions for devices whose manufacturers have given up on upgrading the device entirely. To boot, CyanogenMod includes features you won't find in stock Android, like support for OpenVPN, support for downloadable themes, more privacy tools, and more. You can find a list of supported devices here.Android Open Kang Project (AOKP)The Android Open Kang Project (AOKP) is a relative newcomer compared to many of the other popular ROMs already available, but it's rapidly growing in popularity. It offers many of the features that CyanogenMod has, and at first blush you may mistake one for the other, but as soon as you start looking at the options and add-ons, you'll see the differences. AOKP has earned high marks for add-ons and tools that you can't get in CM, centralized control over ROM options, and overall more customization options than CM. At the same time, its development community is smaller and it may not have the same polish and device support that CyanogenMod has. Still, it's super-fast, it's stable, and definitely worth a look. You can find a list of all supported devices here.MIUIUMIU struck us with how beautiful the user interface was and how elegant it made Android look and feel. It's not the most feature-packed or hackable ROM, but it's definitely one of the most customizable and elegant, and it's seriously fast. MIUI started life as a modded version of Android localized in China, but fans of the mod have since localized it for dozens of languages and countries. It offers strong theme support, beautiful stock apps, customizable lockscreens, support for GApps, and complete root access. You're not going to get a wealth of niche features here, but you will get a device that's much easier and more fun to use once you install MIUI. You can find a list of supported devices here. If you've become a bit bored with the way Android looks and works, MIUI is a completely different...Read moreSlim ICSIf you have a Galaxy Nexus, Nexus S, Samsung Galaxy S or Galaxy S II, Slim ICS may be the ROM for you. Not only will Slim ICS bring your device up to Ice Cream Sandwich, it's also a super-thin, lightweight installation that's remarkably easy to install, even though it's clearly aimed at advanced users. Slim ICS already has GApps rolled in, so you don't need to install them later. Where other ROMs try to add tons of new features and tweaking options, Slim ICS is designed to trim the fat down to the bare essentials and give you a fast and clean ICS installation. It's only available for a handful of Samsung devices and there's pretty much one developer and a few beta testers behind the scenes, so don't expect a ton of feature additions or new devices, but it is updated weekly and sports a good number of third-party mods.Liquid Smooth ROMSLiquid Smooth ROMs are available for multiple devices, and while the project started off with the Motorola Droid, Droid 2, Droid X, Droid Incredible, and HTC Thunderbolt, it's also available for the Galaxy Nexus and a few other devices, although you'll have to poke around the forums a bit to find them. The banner feature of Liquid is that it's probably one of the fastest ICS ROMs available, faster even than the stock install that comes on the Galaxy Nexus. You don't sacrifice features for the speed, but the overall size of the ROM is still nice and small, leaving more space for the apps and features you choose to use, as opposed to ones forced on you. GApps are baked right in, and the ROM offers theme support so you can customize it to your liking. All in all, if you have a supported device, it's probably the leanest, meanest ICS ROM you can download.Now that you've seen the top five, it's time to put them all to a vote and decide the winner.No honorable mentions this week, but you all nominated well over 60 different ROMs for consideration, so whatever ROM you settle on, make sure it's a good match for the features you're looking for, the device you own, and the version of Android you want to run. If you're seeking an alternative to your smartphone or tablet's default keyboard, Microsoft's SwiftKey Keyboard — available on iOS or Android — may be a compelling option. Initially released in 2010, SwiftKey brings artificially intelligent typing predictions, expansive customization, and varied typing style options to your mobile device. Whether you are looking for a new keyboard to boost your typing efficiency, or you simply wish to look at a nicer theme, our tips and tricks will help you get the most out of SwiftKey. Please note some SwiftKey features are only available on Android devices. Backup and Sync your settings (Android & iOS) Before you start customizing SwiftKey for your device, be sure to set up the application's built-in backup function. With this setting enabled, SwiftKey will save data it has learned about your typing style to the cloud, which can then be retrieved by other smartphones or tablets signed in and using the keyboard. New versions of SwiftKey can back up and sync your words across multiple devices when you sign in. On iOS, you can set the backup immediately by signing in with Microsoft, Google, Facebook, or Sign in with Apple. On Android, sign in with Microsoft or Google. If you skip the sign-in step upfront, you can still ensure your backup is enabled by opening the SwiftKey app on your device and going to Account > Backup & Sync. Add a Number Row (Android & iOS) Are you tired of switching to a sub-menu to type numbers? With SwiftKey, you are only a few taps away from adding a number row to your keyboard on either platform. To enable the number row on Android, launch the app, then tap Layout & Keys > Number Row and toggle it on. On iOS, tap Settings >Number Row and toggle on the control. Enable classic SwiftKey gestures (Android & iOS) If you aren't a fan of SwiftKey's Flow feature, which allows you to type a word by merely sliding your finger between the letters, try the Classic SwiftKey mode. To disable SwiftKey Flow and switch to Classic mode, launch the SwiftKey app and navigate to the Typing > Gesture Input > Gestures section on Android or the Microsoft SwiftKey Flow control on iOS. Use the Radio button to select the Gestures option on Android, which will enable Classic Swiftkey mode, which lets you swipe left on the keyboard to delete a word, down to minimize the keyboard, and up to capitalize. For iOS, just toggle off the control. Customize your keyboard theme (Android & iOS) SwiftKey lets you customize how your keyboard looks. You can select from many professionally designed preset themes or build your own keyboard from scratch. To select a keyboard theme, open the Swiftkey app, then select the Themes option. Scroll through the built-in selection of keyboard themes, and choose your favorite by tapping on it. If you want to get more personal, select the Design Your Theme option at the top to create a keyboard based on an image from your photos. Enable multiple languages (Android & iOS) Are you multilingual? SwiftKey Keyboard facilitates using multiple languages for autocorrect and dictionary precision. To add additional keyboard language profiles, open the SwiftKey app and select Languages, and from here, choose and download any additional language options. Android users can select up to five languages, while iOS users can select two. If your language uses a different keyboard layout such as AZERTY instead of QWERTY, you can effortlessly switch between the layouts by holding down the spacebar. Save snippets to the Clipboard (Android & iOS) Do you wish you could save content that you copy in a longer-lasting clipboard? SwiftKey includes a powerful built-in clipboard that saves text for up to one hour. To access your clipboard and paste content from it, begin by bringing up the keyboard and tapping Rich Input > Clipboard, where you will find all of your saved clips from the past hour. On iOS go to Settings > Clipboard to toggle it on. Or tap Add a New Clip to save something. Float your keyboard (Android) Say you don't want your keyboard anchored to the bottom of the screen. You can float it to any position you want, but only if you are using an Android phone. Unlock the keyboard and then tap the three-dot icon on the toolbar. Go to Modes > Float and then tap and drag the two lines at the bottom to reposition the keyboard. To re-dock your keyboard, drag it back to the bottom of your screen. Check your Stats (Android & iOS) Want to see how SwiftKey has improved your typing experience? On Android, go to Typing > Typing stats and view the various categories that SwiftKey tracks. On iOS, just launch the app and scroll down. Usage stats lets you view your Type Map to see how your keyboard has adjusted behind the scenes to fit your typing style, how many typos the keyboard has corrected, the distance your finger has traveled using the Flow feature, the number of words predicted, and more. Insert emojis, GIFs, and photos (Android & iOS) Are you attempting to express emotion via text, but need a GIF or emoji to get the point across? SwiftKey lets you quickly insert an emoji, GIF, or image from your camera roll with just a tap. With the keyboard open, select the Toolbar by tapping the plus icon (+), and then select the type of media you wish to insert. When selecting a GIF or emoji, you can either manually search for the content or use the search bar. Enable Arrow Keys for navigation (Android) If you seek arrow keys to aid text navigation, look no further. Just launch the SwiftKey app on your device and select Layout & keys > Arrow Keys.
